26-2353 Review of Submissions for Design & Installation of Public Artwork for

Veterans Memorial at Julian Feild Park

The City of Mansfield Parks and Recreation Department seeks a mosaic tile mural for the Julian Feild Veterans Memorial Park bridge wall facing Broad Street, measuring 2.5 feet tall by 51 feet long. The all-inclusive budget is \$15,000 (design, materials, installation, and equipment). The design must be strongly patriotic, easily recognizable at 40-mph vehicle speeds, and contain no text to avoid distracting drivers. Installation must be completed between October 5 and October 30 for a November 7 Veterans Day unveiling ceremony. The committee prefers abstract patriotic imagery over literal depictions of military branches. It is open to hybrid approaches (such as a painted mural with mosaic tile accents) to balance aesthetic, cost, and maintenance considerations.
